Gentlemen:

Re: ALFIE ENI, LIMITED

The partnership structure has been purposely designed not to include Harold Weisberg as an equity participant. Rather, it will become his Business Management Consultant Firm on contract with him. (The prospectus was designed solely for viewing by prospective purchasers of equity in ALFIE ENI, LIMITED, not directly in Harold Weisberg).

Harold Weisberg will (and should) remain in control of his own business and academic fate; ALFIE ENI, LIMITED will set in motion an administrative mechanism, which will include promotional and legal representation. ALFIE ENI, LIMITED will be reimbursed for its advanced funds (expenses) from gross profits. ALFIE ENI, LIMITED will then receive one third (1/3rd) of all net monies (profits) accruing to Harold Weisberg for relevant services rendered; these (sans legal matters) have been adequately outlined in the prospectus.

Of whatever net profits we can generate in this cooperative effort, Harold Weisberg (et al) will retain two thirds (2/3rds). In other words, ALFIE ENI, LIMITED will be Harold Weisberg's business legal arm, while he remains doing what he does best.

ALFIE ENI, LIMITED will not share in profits resulting from royalty payments prior to assuming its stated role.


