In response to your letter of 8/14, I will meet you in Washington if that is your desire. At the moment it looks as though the earliest would be 8/25, for I shall be busy the early part of the week.

Again, however, I suggest that if it is at all possible you give me an indication in writing in advance. I do not press you on this, I merely suggest that you think of it.

Should your husband's situation change, I never give thought to surveillance. I am confident it is not the case here and assume it may be true elsewhere. If I worried about that I'd never get anything done.

If you fly down, would you want to go back the same day? We are about an hour from National or Dulles airports. I can get there early for I am used to early rising. However, if you want to stay longer, not have too much travelling to do in a single day, you may find a motel more convenient.
