SUMMARY:

RE BUREAU TEL TO ATLANTA AND MEMPHIS APRIL FIFTEEN LAST AT SEVEN ZERO THREE PM WHICH GAVE THE RESULTS OF BUREAU LABORATORY EXAMINATION.

THIS EXAMINATION AND EVIDENCE OF LESS SIGNIFICANCE AT THIS TIME SINCE IT WAS PICKED UP IN ROOMS ORIGINALLY IDENTIFIED BY MANAGER AS GALT'S ROOMS. MANAGER SUBSEQUENTLY CORRECTED INFORMATION WHICH INDICATED GALT DID NOT STAY IN THESE ROOMS BUT IN ANOTHER ROOM. EVIDENCE FROM LATTER BEING EXAMINED.

CHECKS OF TAXICAB TRIPS RECORDS FROM GREYHOUND BUS TERMINAL TO AREA OF GALT'S ATLANTA RESIDENCE AND ALSO FROM THE RESIDENCE AREA TO ANY DESTINATION ON APRIL FIVE SIXTYEIGHT NEGATIVE TO DATE, BUT CONTINUING.

MRS. ESTELLE PETERS, CLERK, PIEDMONT LAUNDRY BRANCH OFFICE, ONE ONE SIX EIGHT PEACHTREE ST., ATLANTA, AROUND CORNER FROM GALT'S ATLANTA RESIDENCE, ADVISED APRIL SIXTEEN HER RECORDS REFLECT ERIC GALT, NO ADDRESS, PLACED NINE LAUNDRY ITEMS AND THREE DRYCLEANING ITEMS WITH THAT LAUNDRY APRIL ONE, NINETEEN SIXTYEIGHT BETWEEN NINE AND TEN AM. LAUNDRY ITEMS DESCRIBED AS UNDERSHORTS, UNDER SHORTS, SOCKS, AND ONE WAS CLOTH. DRYCLEANING ITEMS DESCRIBED AS MAN'S BLACK CHECK SUIT COAT, GRAY TROUSERS AND BLACK TIE WITH TAN AND BROWN STRIPES. LAUNDRY LEDGER REFLECTS ITEMS PICKED UP APRIL FIVE NINETEEN SIXTYEIGHT SHORTLY AFTER NINE AM BY SAME INDIVIDUAL PLACING LAUNDRY.

MRS. PETERS UNABLE TO FURNISH SUBSTANTIAL DESCRIPTIVE DATA CONCERNING GALT. DESCRIBED HIM AS IN THIRTIES, SLIGHTLY OVER SIX FT., ONE EIGHT FIVE LBS., NEAT IN DRESS AND APPEARANCE, AND ORDINARY COMPLEXION.

LAUNDRY WOULD HAVE LAUNDRY MARK EGC REPEAT EGC EIGHT THREE AFFIXED WITH INDELIBLE PENCIL. DRYCLEANING WOULD HAVE BEEN TAGGED WITH REMOVABLE TAG EIGHT OVER SEVEN FIVE FIVE. NO VEHICLE OBSERVED AND GALT WAS ALONE AT LAUNDRY.
