Nick Ternette v. The Solicitor General Court File No. T-522-84

Having regard to the admissions contained in your letter of September 20, 1985 to Mr. Chumir, the Commissioner under the <u>Privacy Act</u> proposes to re-investigate the complaint made by Mr. Ternette. Notification will be given to the head of the government institution concerned pursuant to s.31 of the <u>Privacy Act</u>. The head of the institution as well as Counsel for Mr. Ternette will have an opportunity to make representations to the Privacy Commissioner pursuant to s.33(2) of the Privacy Act.
