New Probe Eyed Of JFK Assassin

WASHINGTON (AP)—The Senate intelligence committee voted without objection yesterday to recommend a congressional investigation of why Lee Harvey Oswald killed President John F. Kennedy.

Chairman Frank Church, D-Idaho, said the committee voted to turn over its materials on the Nov. 22, 1963, assassination to the proposed new panel to monitor intelligence activities.

In addition, Church said, the committee authorized Sens. Gary Hart, D-Colo., and Richard S. Schweiker, R-Pa., members of a subcommittee to prepare a written report on their investigation of the performance of the CIA, FBI and other intelligence agencies in connection with the assassination.

The report would be completed by the end of the month but must be approved by the full committee before it is made public, Church said.
