What is conspicuous to me is there is, at this very late
date of interview, 1/31/64, no interest in Ferris. It is also
apparent that no reason for interviewing Ciravolo is given.

Possibly a phone call to Ciravolo would be worthwhile.

Let me know if it pays off.

There is another CAP report, less promising, of an
interview with a George Boesch (CDE12:20). Again no reason
given for interview. Emphasis on sling of gun might be interpreted
as diversion. And again, no interest in Ferris.

No Boesch is listed on Humanity St. There is a George E,
same name, at 2724 Manley Ave., 833-1176.

If you do not have time, why not turn these over to Art
Kevin? I'll try and get him by phone in case you'd like him to. Unless
he develops social complications, he might do a few things at night.
