Doubt if he is that stupid, but I want to keep up with everything they say in case. For your information, I had nothing to do with either his arrest or his indictment. I have looked into him some and what I find is not what Lifton talks about, not in any way or sense, as ultimately Dave will learn. He cannot be told in advance for he will not listen. If Dave could only recall how absolutely positive he was about the papier mache trees, he might think about this a bit. But, please, keep me posted at least on what they print....Waiting to hear from Wash COI. Wrote t while back....Do you have copy Gun's book or know how I can get?... What do you know about Hastings Oswald?...Thornley's Oswald was not privately published. New Classics, Chicago, since reorganized. His Idle Warriors was not, to the best of my knowledge ever published, privately or otherwise. Am I wrong?...If you do list again, why not add what you can and also, with books like mine, include how to get. You also ignore two permanent editions, my first two. Dell has these off market in most places, so no alternative anyway....If you do again write Gary Schoener, Box 392, Mayo Hospital, Dept Psych and Psych., Univ Min, Minneapolis, Minn., 55455. He knows of others....Can someone do something about getting my rifle here? I now have right sight want to do some work with it, when I can. I now have three unpublished books. Latest done is CIUO D'ETAT, on all assassinations. POST MORTEM I haven't been able to touch since I saw you. Other on what I regard as a great hazard we will all face that I'll explain when I'm out there again in unread rough draft, just finished. Vince S read two done and things they are best yet. Dear Harold:



Regarding Open City, at least one more series of articles appeared along with rebuttal letters from Lifton, Thornley and yourself (I have no way of knowing if it was your first letter). I ordinarily do not read O.C., but I will procure the back issues you are interested in and mail them to you.

I've culled through our local files on NSRP and I do believe that you have all of it. However, the Washington State CCI and one other local source may yet have something and I've already sent out requests.

A publication which may be of some interest to you has arrived here, unsolicited and in a plain brown wrapper. No, its not a copy of Eros. Rather, it is entitled "First National Directory of 'Rightist' Groups, Publications and Some Individuals in the United States (and Some Foreign Countries); Sixth Edition; Alert Americans Association. There are 4,958 names and addresses, including NSRP. If I get another copy I will send it to you; if you should get your own copy, note #'s 1568 and 2974 for starters.
