Such suggestion like in Rule I had already prepared to ask him for the 2/12 file. The really interesting thing here is that he makes no suggestion of anything of which I have a copy!

Because there was such an executive session and because of the subject matter, having no transcript is even more culpable. Ward and Seal could have supplied a stenographer, as could the Department of Justice or, in a pinch, Congress, which has its own. Even a tape recorder could have been used. That was one of the most historic of all governmental deliberations. It convinces me more than I should do the fact AGWIT should add that the executive sessions should be part. Let us discuss this, among the many, many things.
