A review of the above files was made by SA JOHN T. HOWARD, and the f following is a summary of the information relating to LTE HARVEY OSWALD, and any indications of associations which might be considered conspiratorial, with regard to the assasination of President John F. Kennedy.

DTAN ANDRENS discussed legal matters with LTE HARVEY OSWALD on late June of 1963. ANDRENS recalled that OSWALD was accompanied by an individual named CLAY BERTRAND, and described BERTRAND as "a youthful appearing person age 22-23, 5' 7", 160 pounds, blond- hair and crew cut.

ANDREWS stated he was called later by CLAY BERTRAND and was asked if he would be interested in handling the defense of LES HARVEY OSWALD in

Dallas, Texas, for the murder of President Kennedy.
