SUBJECT: Review of file 89-69, volumes 8,9,10, and file 100-16601, volume 28

A review of the above files was made by SA JOHN E. HOWARD, and the following is a summary of the information relating to LEE HARVEY OSWALD, and any indications of associations which might be considered conspiratorial, with regard to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

1. 89-69, Vol 8, Serial 193.

The Civil Air Patrol unit to which both OSWALD and FERRIS were supposed to belong, ~~89-11/26/69~~, reportedly met with with some Cubans who were on military training at an undisclosed location, while on an overnight campout on July, 1961.

2. 89-69, Vol 10, Serial 236.

DEAN ANDREWS discussed legal matters with LEE HARVEY OSWALD on late June of 1963. ANDREWS recalled that OSWALD was accompanied by an individual named CLAY BERTRAND, and described BERTRAND as "a youthful appearing person age 22-23, 5' 7", 160 pounds, blonde hair and crew cut.

ANDREWS stated he was called later by CLAY BERTRAND and was asked if he would be interested in handling the defense of LEE HARVEY OSWALD in Dallas, Texas, for the murder of President Kennedy.

Review of 89-69, Vol 9, and 100-16601, Vol 28, failed to reflect any relative information.
