Clark presented an award given to Spock by the New Jersey chapter of the American Civil Liberties Union.

In making the presenta-tion Saturday night, Clark

said:
"I have come to indict
Dr. Spock again, on three
counts. One, putting the
love of people against his
own self-interest; secondly nersevering for peace own self-interest; secondly, persevering for peace,
and, thirdly, conspiring to
do this with youth, joy,
grace and dignity rarely
seen on this earth."

Spock was convicted of
conspiring to counsel
young men to evade the
draft but the conviction
was overturned.
