

Frazier wrote this 11/26/69 letter to Howard Roffman, for Hoover's signature.

The requests pertained to the characteristics of the slits on the front of JFK's shirt.

Frazier referred Howard to Frazier's commission testimony, 5H60-2.

Based on this testimony, Frazier states, "further examination would serve no useful purpose."

This is contrary to his deposition testimony. He then testified that he had Stombaugh(?) make exactly the examination Howard requested. The results of this examination of the characteristics of the damage to the shirt are not included in any meaningful way in Frazier's testimony, and no such test results are known to have been provided to the Commission or were provided in C.A. 75-226.
