Dear Promotions Director,

This is intended for Prs. Leslie Cockburn but on the chance that she is promoting her excellent Out Of Control and that you may be interested in the content I write her through you.

When Meese had his White House press conference 11/25/86 he represented that he had just learned about the mess. He was asked if he had the FBI investigating. Its massive Winvestigation" of the assassination of President Kennedy was and is not a law enforcement investigation.

By his inaction, covered by his lie, beese assured time to destroy evidence. If the FBI had been asked to investigate the Washington Field Office would have sent enough agents immediately to protect everything and probably enough to question witnesses and have reports at headquarters in the morning. (FBIHQ does not conduct investigations.)

There are several references to Soldier of Fortune Magazine but I recall none to Robert K. Brown, who publishes it. The committees did not follow up when Robert Owen testified that North had sent him to Colorado to confer with people he named, including Robert K. Brown. I once knew him well. Beginning with some copies of FBI records from the Warren Commission's files that I enclose. Thereafter we knew each other well enough for him to ask my help with an anti-CIA book. I declined.

Brown is so exemplary a patriot that he didn't report it when he was propositioned to kill the President, and others. He admitted this when someone he had told informed the FBI after JFK was killed. All that happened to Frown is that the Army reserves promoted him from captain to major.

I also enclose a Miami police report that mentions him and others in connection with a bombing and a page of a reporter's notes. I believe this was Dan Christensen of the Miami Herald or News, I think now in or near St. Petersburg. No, it is the News, office phone 305/376-3627, home, 305/763-8778. "Scherer" in the notes is corrected illegibly.

Before has started the current magazine he provided probably as much if not more information that could be used by terorists than anyone else in this country. He did business under the name "Palladin Press" where he now is and he provided all kinds of information on all kinds of weapons and explosives, to a substantial audience. Of course, that also was patriotism. So, Ollie really knew who to send Owen to, huh?

You refer to Summit aviation in passing. It was given some attention when a U.S. plane crashed into am El Salvador volcano one night several years ago. Right away the wrong volcano, one 20 miles rather than right at the capital was identified, incorrectly. Necessary to one of the cover stories, that it was tracking Nicaraguan planes delivering munitions to the rebels. Something they'd hardly do right over the capital. But the plane might have been there using VN technology for locating rebels

The part of shat came out about Summit is that it had a large runway, paid for by the U.S. Government, so that corporate jets bound for Philadelphia could save time by landing there. I think the location is Treenwood, Qelaware. This is so false it has to have been a rushed cover story because there is no time saving in landing about 30 miles south of Wilmington. Which has a modern and underused airport. (I used to live there and worked on the morning paper.) horeover, unless they have all been developed, there used to be many small airports all around Thiladelphia, including in New Jersey which, by the bifdges, is quite close to most of Thiladelphia.

This office received information from Asst. State Attorney Dave Goodhart, that the persons responsible for the recent bombings in the Dade County area have run out of explosives and are attempting to purchase some from revolutionary groups or organizations.

Various informants utilized by this office were given the above informati in an effort to determine which revolutionary groups have explosives and if anyone is attempting to buy same.

On Aug. 31, 1967 information received from a reliable confidential informant that a revolutionary group, residing at 1925 S.W. 4 Street, had in their possession a warehouse loaded with arms, ammunition and C4 explosives. An immediate surveillance of the aforememblened locations was established by this office and the following was learned.

A number of persons, most of which appear to be American soldiers of fortun residing and meeting in a large downstairs room at 1925 S.W. 4th Street, are some sort of a revolutionary group. It later developed that several of these persons were under indictment by the U.S. Government for attempti to leave from Occoa Plum Key, Monroe County, Fla. on a mission to invade Haaiti.

By keeping these persons under surveillance and through license tag check the following names were developed:

Persons who visited the above subjects:

Peter Ojtozy, 181 W. 8 St. Hialeah. -61 Green V.W. 1D-270 (67 Fla.)

Donald Willis, address unknown - 66 Comet -HW 661 (67 Illinois)

Most of the aforementioned persons were tailed by officers of this unit from Aug. 31, 1967 to Sept. 14, 1967 with negative results. No warehouse was ever visited by any of the above during our surveillance. Contact with this office was made by subject Martin Casey and further information is being learned; however it is doubtful that the above mentioned organiz has access to C4 explosives.

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MEMORANDUM TO THE FILES - MAY 28, 1968:

It was learned that one of the largest gun dealers in the country is run by Tony Scherar, who has a large establishment near O'Hare Airport in Chicago.

After the JFK assassination, the FBI informed the Treasury Department that Sherar had a cannon or a mortat that was capable of sighting on O'Hare Airport.

When LHJ scheduled a trip to Chicago, A&TT tried to divert Sherar from his property until LBJ had come and gone. However, they were unsuccessful and Sherar sued Treasury Tept. for \$100,000. The suit went to the U.S. Supreme Court and it was held that Federal agents guarding the President could take said actions which might be unconstitutional under other circumstances.

Sherar travels widely, makes much money, but has no criminal record.

It is believed that one of Sherar's closest friends is Robert K. (Pete) Brown.

Sherar is licensed to sell any kind of a gun, including machine guns.

It was suggested that someone else in whom we might have an interest is Dr. Torres, a medical doctor Near Pekin, Illinois, who has an FAA license.
