We received information that the above subject was arrested running from the City Hall after the shooting of Lee Harvey Ocyald.

I contacted Sergeant, J. F. Everett December 13, 1963. Sorgeant Everett stated as follows:

"I was on duty in the Dispatcher's Office and had walked into the hall of the third floor at the time of the shooting. Democra shouted to becure the building and I ran down the stems to the first floor. There I saw the subject william Cofficer Re T. Davis \$1867 and myself apprehended the subject on the steps of the City Hall. He was taken to the Mamieide Lureau and interrogated by Detective T. L. Daker. It was determined this subject was apparently sight-seeing on the first floor. He was later released.

This investigation of William Coffney has not been carried any farther at this time.
