I have finally finished reading "Whitewash II."

There are certain things in "Whitewash II" which I hope you will call to the attention of Richard A. Sprague of the House Committee on Assassinations, if you have not already done so.

The first is the Altgens photo. If your conclusion is correct and it is Oswald in the doorway of the Texas School Book Depository, then the whole Warren Report collapses like a house of cards.

In fact, the whole volume is the strongest indictment of the Warren Report I have seen to date.

The second is the mysterious Col. Castorr.

Another is Tom Howard.

An old friend of yours, Jacob Cohen, had a series of two articles in The Saratogian, Saratoga Springs, N. Y. The first was published Oct. 5. Unfortunately, I didn't catch the second which was to be titled: "One man or not?"

The editor's note describes Cohen as "a professor of American studies at Brandeis University" as and "the author of 'Conspiracy Fever,' to be published this at later this year by Macmillan."

The article is bylined "Special, Washington Post."

Understandably, Prof. Cohen takes a dim view of critics of the Warren Report. He refers to the "...conspiracy lobby, a lobby made up of professional and anaxis amateur critics of the Warren Commission who spring to flamboyant attention at the first hint of congressional interst(sic)."
