Dear Dr. Cohen,

As soon as she can my wife will copy the Part | Section of the CIA's release that Marks used.

The CIA has not sent me the most recent one nor has it notified me of it.

If they stonewall me on this I'll wait them out. But I'll be glad to get a set of them from Marks for you if you'd like.

I'm also sure Mike Conkling would be willing to do this.

Otherwise you'll also be delayed.

I have written them about this. They should reply by telling me how large a check to send. I'll then let you know if they do.

First reference was to 4,000 pages. Then I saw 5,000. Next I heard a news item referring to 8,000.

If there are indications that they will not be stonewalling me on this I'll ask about a second set for you without your going to the bettem of their list.

I'm glad to help in any way I can but as I think I explained my present activity is somewhat reduced by a combination of a post-phlebitic condition and something else as yet undiagnosed.

If you have no independent means of learning when the recent hearings are printed like Conklin will be following that more closely than I. Sometimes there is a considerable lag. Normally they are available at Government Printing Office stores. I'm sure there is one in Los Angeles. I know there is in San Francisco.
