**CIA Official Named
To State Dept. Post**

Washington, March 3—(AP)—G. Marvin Gentile, an official of the Central Intelligence Agency, has been appointed deputy assistant secretary of state for security.

Gentile succeeds John Reilly, who resigned last November.

Gentile, 42, was a special agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation between 1946 and 1962, when he joined the CIA. He served CIA in "various executive capacities having to do with security matters," a State Department announcement said.
