

SPONSORED BY THE COMMITTEE TO INVESTIGATE ASSASSINATIONS

On November 12, 1973 a representative of another government agency which conducts security type investigations made available a program schedule for a two day conference at Georgetown University, Washington, D.C. during the period of November 23-24, 1973. The schedule reflects that the conference is being sponsored by the Committee to Investigate Assassinations, 1520 16th Street, Northwest, Washington, D.C.. A copy of the program schedule is attached.

Re WFO airtel and LHM dated 11/13/73 and captioned as above.

Referenced WFO LHM and attachment set forth the details and a schedule of captioned conference inasmuch as WILLIAM TURNER, a former Bureau agent, and GEORGE O'TOOLE, former CIA agent were scheduled speakers.

On 12/12/73 Agent DOUGLAS LAIRD, United States Secret Service, Washington, D. C., advised that he attended the two day conference and that TURNER acted as moderator for one of the sessions and that he took no part in the discussion and that he made no separate speeches during the conference. TURNER was introduced as a former Bureau agent and as an author. LAIRD advised that O'TOOLE spoke regarding the use and accuracy of Psychological Stress Evaluator (PSE).

LAIRD also advised that 115-120 persons attended the conference with one third of the group of college age who attempted to relate the assassination of JOHN F. KENNEDY to Watergate and the remainder of the persons interested in

learning all possible regarding assassinations. The theme that evolved from the conference was that more than one person was involved in the assassination of KENNEDY and that public interest should be increased regarding assassinations.

No additional investigation being conducted by WFO. This case is being placed in a closed status.
