Mrs. FERNA REYNOLDS, Manager, Tanglewood Apartments, 3909 Inwood, stated that on Wednesday night, November 20, 1963, FRANK T. TORTORIELLO, residing Apartment 104, had held an all-night party in his apartment. Mrs. REYNOLDS stated she had "called him on the carpet" after receiving complaints from Mrs. W. B. HUNTER, Apartment 101, concerning the noise which persisted throughout the night. Mrs. REYNOLDS stated that on one previous occasion FRANK TORTORIELLO and JOE FREDERICA, of Apartment 110, had hired a "shir-tail" band on a Sunday P.M. and they had played around the swimming pool of the Tanglewood Apartments, causing quite a bit of consternation to the tenants. TORTORIELLO had invited all of the adjacent tenants to attend this concert and stated they had only played for an hour, but she had cautioned TORTORIELLO about such incidents at the time.

In reference to the party held by TORTORIELLO on November 20, 1963, she stated that she did not know whether or not JADA attended but did know that Mrs. ANN BRYANT, Apartment 106, JOE FREDERICO and his wife, as well as FENTON BAKER, JR., had also attended this party.

Mrs. REYNOLDS concluded that she did know, however, that JADA had at various times been in TORTORIELLO's apartment; #104.

 FRANK T. TORTORIELLO advised that at a party he had at his apartment, No. 104 Tanglewood Apartments, 3909 Inwood, on November 20, 1963, the only resident of the Tanglewood Apartments attending this particular party was ANN BRYANT who occupies Apt. 106 in the same apartment building.

TORTORIELLO stated specifically that JACK RUBY had never attended a party at his apartment, and further stated that "JADA" (JEANNETTE CONFORTO) had not attended the party held on November 20, 1963.

TORTORIELLO also stated that neither JOE FREDERICI or his wife, SANDY FREDERICI, had attended this particular party. He stated at this time that he had received a telephone call from "JADA" from New York City over the past weekend advising him that she had been interviewed by Agents of the New York City Office, that she was going to New Orleans and would come to Dallas from New Orleans either Thursday or Friday, December 12 or 13, 1963.
