(4) "The early Christians noted the moral uniqueness of Jesus; to make this uniqueness plausible, they devised a mythological story of Jesus" (quoted in St. Louis Globe Democrat, Dec. 1963).
(5) "I'm not concerned with the deity of Christ. His virginity, His bodily resurrection--are peripheral (insignificant) relative minor (unimportant) issues" (quoted in National Observer, Dec. 30, 1963).
(6) "I'm not concerned with the New Jerusalem, I'm concerned with the New Atlanta, the New Birmingham, the New Montgomery, the New South" (quoted in Life, Nov. 7, 1960).

Bureaucrats Switch Line Regarding Treason Road

After Two Years
Officials Admit to

WASHINGTON--Two years ago Hide newspaper in Shreveport, La., The Counselor, revealed that Russia and the United States were working together to build a military highway across the land mass of Asia.
The Counselor dubbed the road as "Treason Highway" and urged readers to write their congressmen to prevent this joint U. S.-Soviet venture. Dozens of congressmen claim that there was no such road. Genial that there was no evidence of Soviet participation.

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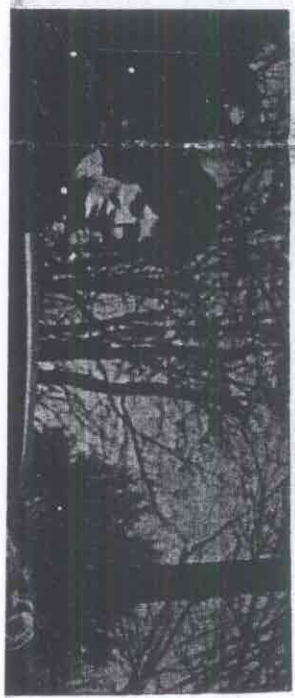

Fourth Bullet Dastards
Warren Report

Witnesses at Dallas have sworn that four or more bullets were fired in the complex murder of President Kennedy. The Warren Report's shaky conclusion that Lee Harvey Oswald was a lone assassin rests absolutely that only government's contention that only three bullets were fired. The location of a fourth bullet near the back of the presidential limousine is a political episode of high-placed government officials with connections which appears in the Warren Report.

In the same shell casings were found in the same place where the Warren File contends Lee Oswald fired at Kennedy. A majority of witnesses, including Secret Service agents, testified that all of the shots--whether three or more--were fired within a period of not more than 5 to 6 seconds.

The Warren Commission found that the time span between the first shot to strike Kennedy and the bullet which struck the shell was 4.8 to 5.6 seconds, based on the Zapruder film of the assassination made with a camera with an operating speed of 18.3 seconds per frame.

The antiquated rifle blamed for the death would have been hard-pressed to make three (aimed) shots in this brief work of time. It could not have made four.

Count Them Yourself

This is how the Warren Commission accounted for the three bullets and the disposition of the bullet:

(1) W. C. contends the first bullet hit Kennedy in the back, turned upward through his body to exit through his necktie hole, thence made another right-hand turn in midair to strike Gov. Connally, struck the right fifth rib and went on to pierce against the governor's wrist. W. C. contends that a bullet, only slightly damaged and presented as Commission Exhibit 389 is this magical, existing, turning projectile.

(2) W. C. contends the second bullet missed Kennedy, struck a

Garrison Established That a Crossfire Killed John Kennedy

NEW ORLEANS -- District Attorney Jim Garrison failed to convince a Louisiana jury that Clay Shaw was guilty of participating in the conspiracy to murder President Kennedy, but the jury made a convoluted effort to show that a conspiracy did, in fact, exist.

Much of the Garrison case, unreported in depth in daily papers, established that Kennedy was killed in a crossfire. This testimony is now part of the official record and it stands virtually unchallenged.

Garrison's case, in general, was against former Eastern Airlines Pilot David Ferris who died mysteriously, in Shreveport. The Councilor implicated Ferris in the assassination about two years before Garrison made his public charges, but The Councilor did not name Shaw as a participant. LEADING TRACKS OF LEAD AND ANTIMONY, and then recaptured into the face of James Edgar. (3) W. C. contends the third bullet exploded Kennedy's head, and was the fatal fragment in the death car (Hwy) came from this bullet.

Application of Logic

If the bullet which hit Connolly did not first pass through Kennedy, then reason the entire case against Oswald as the lone assassin falls completely apart. (There is much other supporting evidence to show that Kennedy was killed in a cross fire and that Oswald was not the No. 1 triggerman, but the discovery of a fourth bullet would be sufficient to disprove the Warren Report.)

The Conductor Investigation Team believes that the bullet which hit Connolly did not pass through the body of President Kennedy. The bullet which hit the governor, according to his physician, entered at an angle of 27 degrees. A straight line to the 6th floor of the Book Depository from the point of this impact is less than 18 degrees; besides, science has yet to develop a bullet which will turn in mid-air.

The bullet in possession of The Conductor shows no fracture of the outer casing except, possibly, a pinpoint hole. It is doubtful that enough lead could have passed through a pinpoint hole to leave the traces found on the Dallas curb. Conductor Investigation Team believes that a thorough ballistic study will rule out this bullet as being the one which left tracks on the curb.

If only four bullets were fired—and this was one of the first—it would have to be the first—hit which hit Kennedy.

His insolence threatens our womanhood, and our children are beaten by Negro toughs on the way to school, while we pay his taxes. Shall we longer tolerate Negro inspectors of white schools, and Negroes in charge of white institutions? Shall we longer tolerate the arrest of white women by Negro officers and their trial before Negro magistrates?"

"Let the manhood of the Aryan race with its four thousand years of authentic history answer that question!

"It is no longer a question of bad government. It is a question of impossible government. We lag behind the age dragging the decaying corpse to which we are chained.

"Who shall deliver us from the body of this death?"

"Hear me, men of my race, Norman and Celt, Angle and Saxon, Dane and Frank, Hungenot and German martyr blood!

"The hour has struck when we must rise in our might, break the chains that bind us to this corruption, strike down the Negro as a ruling power, and restore to our children their birthright, which we received, a priceless legacy, from our fathers!

"I believe in God's call to our race to do

pen in the hand of a madman to transform by its magic a million slaves into a million kings.

"We grant the Negro the right to life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness if he can be happy without exercising kingship over the Anglo-Saxon race, or dragging us down to his level. But if he can not find happiness except in lordship over a superior race, let him look for another world in which to rule. There is not room for both of us on this continent! . . . It took Spain 800 years to expel the Moors. When the time comes the Anglo-Saxon can do in one century what the Spaniard did in eight.

"We have been congratulated on our self-restraint under the awful provocation of the past four years. There is a limit beyond which we dare not go, for at this point, self-restraint becomes pusillanimous and means the loss of manhood.

"I ask you, my people freemen . . . to rise today and make good your right to live! The time for platitudes is past. Let us as men face the world and say what we mean.

"This is a white man's government, conceived by white men, and maintained by white men through every year of its history, - and by the God of our Fathers it shall be ruled by white men until the Arch-angel shall call the end of time!"

"I tried to write with the utmost restraint" . . . Dixon

Did you, dear reader, think the above speech was made today? Actually it tells of the South's struggle in another tragic period known as the Reconstruction Era, 1865-1900, which the South won. The above is a composite of two speeches from the remarkable pen of historical novelist Thomas Dixon, Jr.

The first speech, as shown, is from "The Clanman," (movie title: "The Birth of a Nation"), published in 1905. Dixon's publisher, Secretary of State read the proofs of this book and pronounced its history unassailable before the author would allow it to go to press. At Mr. Hay's request the author presented the proofs to him for his personal library."

The second oration, under the heading, "A Speech that Made History," is from "The Leopard's Spots," 1902. Of this work, Dixon's publisher says it, "is the fruit of more than 20 years of patient thought and study on the relations of the white and black races in America. It is an historical revelation as well as a romance." In his preface, Dixon writes, in 1902: "It will be a century yet before people outside the South can be made to believe a literal statement of the history of those times. I tried to write this book with the utmost restraint."

Dixon, a North Carolinian, was a college graduate, state legislator, and minister, having held the pastorate of leading churches in Boston and New York. Not only was he an enormously popular novelist, he became the most popular Lyceum lecturer in America and addressed over four million people.

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On the Trail of the Red-Headed Man

In the last issue of *The Councilor* we pondered what happened to the white men who built a great civilization in South America long before Columbus came to America, those legends hold that these white men sailed into the Pacific many centuries ago.

Over 2,000 miles westward of Peru, and somewhat closer to the cool weather of the Antarctic is the lonely island of Rapa Nui, known to Americans as Easter Island. This island is presently administered by Chile, and is populated by two types of natives, the long-ears and the short-ears.

The long-ears are immensely proud of their ancestry, their Caucasian features and their obvious talents for engineering tools and artistic attainment. Some of the long-ears have flaming red hair. Ancient mummified heads found in caves have rested in their ceremonial crypts for centuries.

A Norwegian expedition reports that the hair on these heads is red. This feature of the island was "discovered" (or rediscovered) on Easter Day, 1722 by a Dutch navigator named Roggveen, sailors aboard Roggveen's two sailing ships noticed smoke signals were being sent from the island. They dropped anchor.

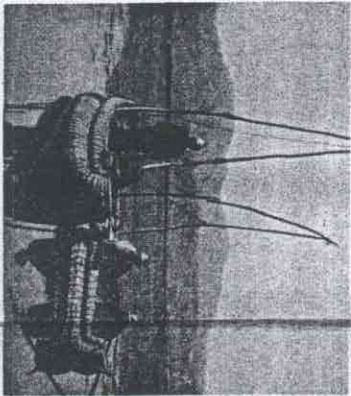
Natives who came on to the ships were tall, well-built people and fair-skinned. They resembled in many ways the Polynesians of Tahiti and Hawaii, but among them

were evidences of race-mixing. Some had dark skin, while others were "very white" and could pass as Europeans. Roggveen's count described some of them as having a reddish tint, as if some were burnt by the sun. Many had beards.

Roggveen told that the natives seemed to revere giant stone figures on the island—and that each of these huge statues was topped by a flaming red cylinder.

Among the first natives to board the ship was one adorned with a crown of feathers. He seemed to be the ruler. In his ears were round white pegs as large as flint. More surprising: This great king or high priest was described as a "completely white man."

Nearly 50 years later (1770) the island was visited by two Spanish ships under command of Don Felipe Gonzalez. Again, smoke signals. These Spaniards told of finding tall, fair men. Two

of the largest were measured. One stood 6 feet 6 1/2 inches tall and the other was 6 feet 6 inches. Many had beards and some of these were "like Europeans."

Although some looked Polynesian with blue-black hair, others had an apparent higher caste, had half of chestnut brown. Some of the latter had reddish and cinnamon-colored hair.

When they got these natives to repeat clearly in Spanish, "Ave Maria, long live Charles III, King of Spain," the visitors agreed that they had found an intelligent people who could easily be civilized. (An English translation of the

ancient papers and logbooks recording Roggveen's and Gonzalez's visits to Easter Island can be found in Vol. 13 of the Hakluyt Society, published in Cambridge, England, in 1908.)

Other early visits were recorded by Captain Cook, the Frenchman La Perouse, and the Russian expedition, 1803-1804. The Red-headed natives were not regarded as "beastly" as some of the other natives of the Pacific Ocean? There were no boats on Easter Island for transportation and red hair.

The natives brought to Hegerdahl ancient stone carvings of

women who after three days sailing jumped overboard and drowned. The cruel Massachusetts enterprise returned for a fresh load of captives for an effort to populate a sealing station on Fernandis Island. Later expeditions were unable to land because natives threw down rocks from high cliffs.

A Russian expedition finally succeeded in landing, with the help of guns, but after a few hours were repulsed by the clever natives. Each expedition which had a chance to record a visit with the natives told of fewer, and fewer people.

A Norwegian expedition in 1865, headed by Thor Heyerdahl, unlocked many secrets of Easter Island. They found a long-ear mayor with white skin and European features. The mayor claimed to be of pure stock and showed great pride in his red-haired children.

When the expedition was stumped by the mystery of how enormous stone statues were carved, the crew of long-ears (with predominant white skin) to carve one with stone axes!

The expedition was baffled by the mystery of how natives could have raised the statues (as tall as a 3-story building) to an upright position. The three poles and a pile of dry stones, raised such a statue. In doing so, the demonstrated that while many a genius could have used the same engineering techniques to build the pyramids of Egypt, Mexico and Peru.

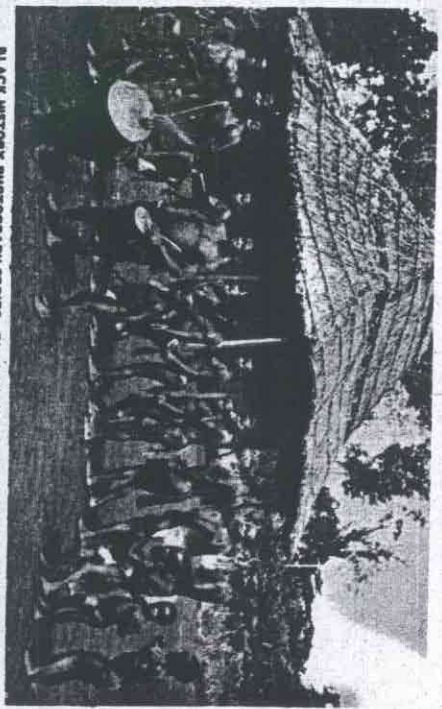

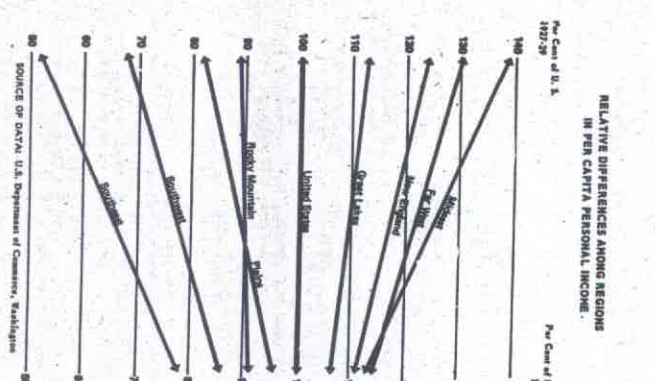
Switch of Emphasis Among Unitarians

CHARL ESTON, S. C.—Prior to the Civil War rich whites were Massachusetts, South Carolina and Louisiana.

After the war, punitive legislation and various forms of taxation payments drained the wealth of the southern states into Bavarian banking centers under the complete control of the Rothschild Family of Bavaria, New York and London prospered as white and negro populations of the South were reduced to absolute poverty in a planned program of theft.

As late as 1952, the per capita income of the Southern States was only slightly more than a third as high as the per capita income of persons living in New York, Pennsylvania and New Jersey, according to calculations of the U.S.
