This letter is to explain why your Councilor is late.

Our problem? We don't own our press. We have the paper printed by a private firm and that firm is "going under." For more than a year the paper has not been printed as quickly as we wished, and the quality of printing leaves much to be desired.

We must buy our own press. This will not only lower our unit cost, but will assure us of being able to get The Councilor printed ON TIME.

This will do three things:

- (1) Make it possible for The Councilor to grow to a million circulation, through an extensive sampling program with a high-quality, ON-TIME publication.
- (2) We will make the press available for AT COST printing for other patriotic publications which suffer the same problem as we do.
- (3) We will be able to serve patriotic organizations throughout America by preparing and mailing "Special Editions" of The Councilor dealing with local problems.

The Councilor is a non-profit educational organization which, in effect belongs to its readers. We hope to eventually become a large, national weekly paper. We are already the largest newspaper of this type in America.

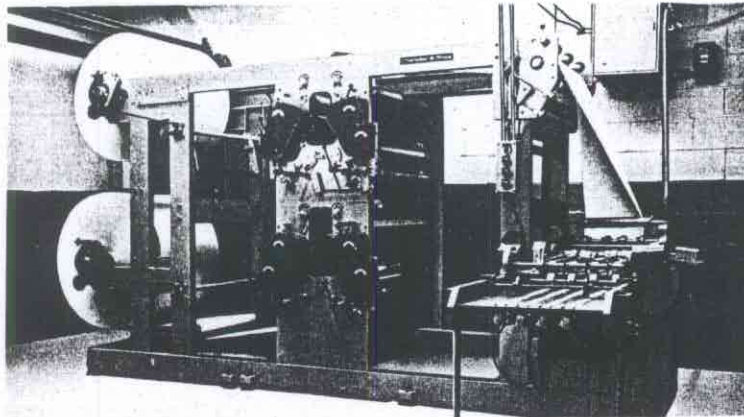
A PRESS WILL PAY FOR ITSELF IN FORTY MONTHS UNDER THIS PLAN, but because of our controversial status we can't lease.
