Robert Larsen, the producer of the projected film, said background footage was shot Saturday in Dallas and during the past few days at his studio in Colorado Springs, Colo.

Among the directors of the corporation that is producing the film are Henry M. Wade, the District Attorney at the time of the assassination who still holds that office, and Jesse Curry, who was the Dallas Police Chief in November, 1963. Marvin Thomas, Mr. Wade's slaw partner, is president of the corporation, known as Flag-Star Inc.
