

Dear Mom & Dad -

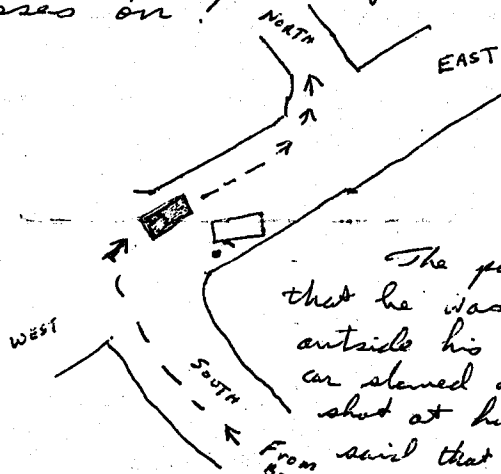
This is a picture of the getaway car after it crashed into a telephone pole at a speed of almost 100 MPH.

- Police officer

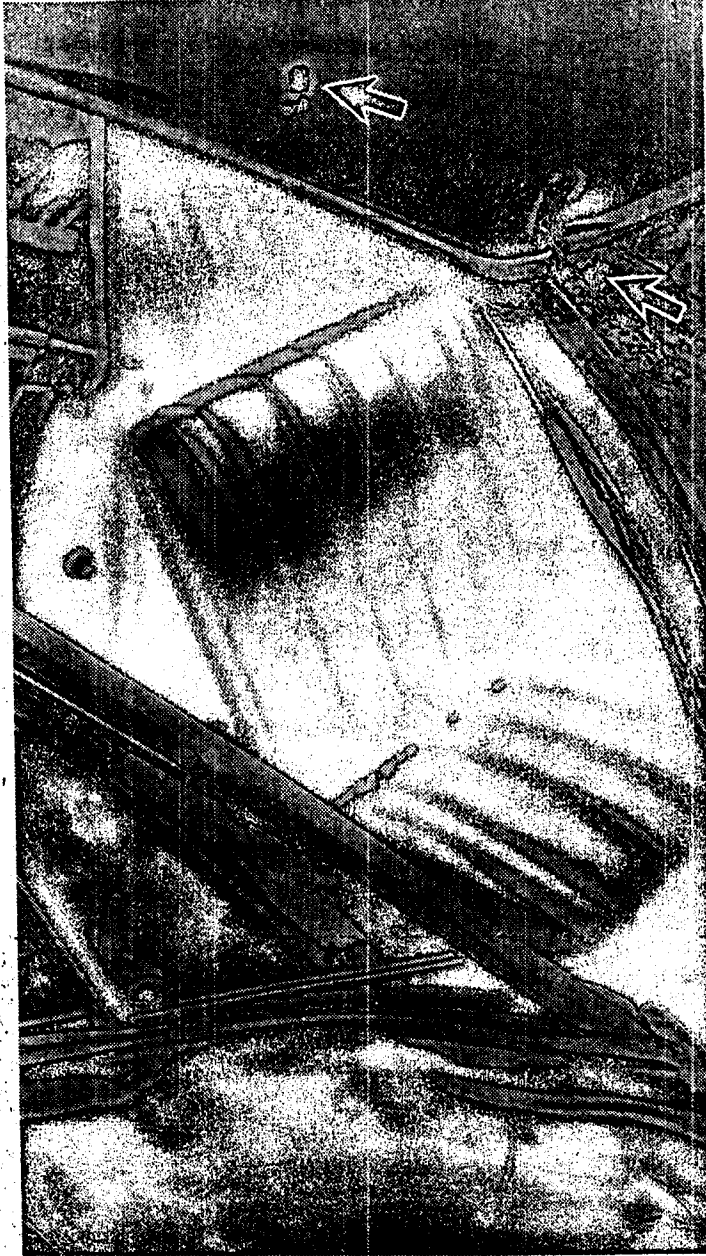


The police officer said that he was standing right outside his car when the getaway car slowed down and somebody shot at him! A witness said that one of the robbers was leaning out the window!
