MEMORANDUM FOR MESSRS. BOGERT AND GIBBERT:

RE: Interrogation of Curtis LaVergne Craford

Mr. Malley has called me regarding your effort to obtain items of evidence in Dallas for use during the interrogation of Craford. He informed me that District Attorney Wade is reluctant to surrender any evidence in his possession. If we want it I think we will have to discuss it with Mr. Sartin and then place a call to Mr. Wade. If we are satisfied with photographs the Federal Bureau of Investigation may be able to help us. Mr. Malley says the Dallas office probably has photographs of all the items and the Washington office has most of the photographs. We should let the FBI know Monday whether photographs will suffice.
