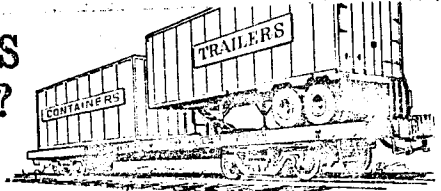

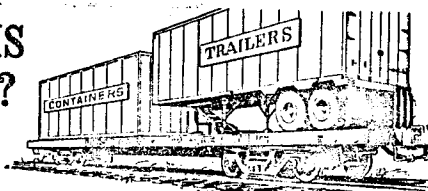

Arch Kimbrough, Dallas contractor, is CIA agent or informer. Prob. agent. He controls Mary Ferrell, Mary controls Penn & Bill Boxley. Arch is dying from cancer. Sue Fitch, supposed to be interested in assassination. Has asked Roger numerous times to agree to interview with Sue. Roger refused -- Mary said "How much?" Roger said \$1,000 for 1 hr. Never heard from Mary about it since. Mary confused Jim Harrison by convincing him she had deciphered & de-coded phone numbers to names & vice-versa. Attempted to, & did, to some extent, throw Jim off the track. Boxley owes Mary \$800 she loaned him. She offered to loan Roger money & he declined -- would not be indebted to the likes of Mary Farrell. She has tried to get something on Roger to hold over his head but can't -- he's clean.

Boxley left CIA in 1955. An alcoholic. Still an informer like Oswald -- gets about \$200 a month. Wants to work for Roger as investigator but Roger doesn't trust him. Thinks he wants to report on his operation to Mary. Any illegal step by one of his investigators could result in Rog losing his license. This is what they're after. Roger wants to & has tried to meet

Mary's husband, Buck, but in 8 yrs,
has not been able to. Roger thinks he
may have seen Buck & will recognize
him. Roger says the Farrells ^{are} ~~do~~ not
~~were~~ minute-men, as Penn says.

Mary called & told Roger a contract
was out on Roger. He knew the
head of Dallas mafia, R.D. Matthews.
He went to the Ali Baba Club, which
Matthews owned & found Matthews &
his 3 top "Deputies", A.D. McComas (or Thomas)
George McBann & Nick Cassio sitting
at a table. He asked Matthews if a
contract was out on him & Matthews
said "Hell, no. If there was, I'd do it
now. I own this club & nobody is
here but us". (Mary told Roger the
order was issued in N.D.) He called
Mary & related his conv. w/ Matthews
& she said "O, must have been bad info".
If Roger had believed her, she could
have taken credit for protecting him
& saving him, putting him in her debt.
George McBann found dead later
