George DeMohrenschildt, a prominent member of the Dallas Russian community and a very close friend of Lee Harvey Oswald, is now head of the Russian Language Department at the University of Texas at Arlington. DeMohrenschildt has some of the most amazing testimony in the entire eighteen thousand pages of the Warren Commission testimony, but he seems to be faring quite well after the assassination.

On the other hand, former Deputy Sheriff and assassination witness, Roger Craig has been fired twice since he gave testimony contrary to the Warren Commission conclusions. He has been shot at once and is currently being followed again. He was "tailed" for a week preceding the shooting attempt on November 1, 1967 which took place on the streets of Dallas. Not only is Craig, 31, unable to get work in the Dallas area, he is unable to rent a house or an apartment in Dallas.
