We have prepared another redraft of the conclusions and narrative statement and I hope that we will have that in galley proof this next week and that you may examine it at that time. The Commission has made it a requirement that all such proofs must be read by anyone other than Commissioners at the offices of the Commission, so I trust you can come here as soon as I notify you next week.

I am pleased to learn that you and Charles Murray visited Dallas and reviewed the site of the assassination and the route of both the President and Lee Harvey Oswald. I also note that you have reviewed the physical evidence and Mr. Oswald's activities in Mexico City. I shall advise the Commission of your activity in each of these respects.

It would be most helpful to us if you would advise us promptly of any suggestions you may have for further investigation by the Commission since we are trying to draw our work to a close and complete our Report in a very few days.
