Sylvia Meagher suggests you might have taped the Long John Knebel show. I would very much like a tape of it if you have, and at any speed. Our machine passes only 1 7/8 and 3 3/4 ips, and takes a 5" reel. It would fit on both sides of a single reel of half mil.

The Alen Burke people promised me the sound tape of that program, but I have not gotten it and have not heard from them. Naturally, I'm anxious to have a record of this, too. The reaction to it has been quite exciting and continues with only slight diminution. I want these tapes only as a record, hence speed means nothing.

If you can help me with either or both of these I'd very much appreciate it. Enclosed is a copy of the index and four extra appendix pages of the recent reprinting of WHITEHALL. Until the older copies clear the stores, I'd like as little attention paid this as possible.

Do you have any idea who those lawyers are, who they represent, who organized them? I presume whoever did is as unhappy as the lawyers, but my curiosity is as great as my indebtedness.
