

CRISMAN GETS N.O. SUMMONS

JFK Plot Probe Figure to
Make Trip

TACOMA, Wash. (AP)—Fred Lee Crisman was served Wednesday with a subpoena to appear before a New Orleans grand jury in the assassination of John F. Kennedy.

Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison of New Orleans issued the subpoena in his probe into the Kennedy assassination.

Crisman, 48, of the Tacoma area, has been subpoenaed with a provision that would prevent his arrest in New Orleans.

The Orleans Parish grand jury has indicted two persons, Clay and Stanley Lee, in the Kennedy assassination.

It said the slayer was Lee Oswald and closed its investigation.

Accompanying the subpoena for Crisman was a check for a little more than \$500. Crisman said he would contact Garrison's office to try to get a larger sum so his attorney, Robert Griffin, could accompany him to New Orleans.

Crisman, who also uses the names Fred Lee and Dr. Jon Beckman, is a partner of Thomas Edward Beckman, who has testified before the grand jury.
