Conservatives Wary on Cuba

New York State's Conservative party, in a sharp criticism of United States policy toward Cuba, said today that the Communists would make gains of "historic magnitude" in Latin America unless Washington reversed its policy toward Cuba. Frank S. Meyer, chairman of the party's international affairs committee and senior editor of the National Review, attacked the United States Government's curb on anti-Castro guerrilla efforts.
