## **CUBAN IS CONFIDENT REFUGEES CAN UNITE**

MIAMI, May 28—Dr. Carlos Prío Socarras, former President of Cuba, believes that unity will be achieved by the exiles to fight against Premier Fidel Castro and Communism in Cuba.

The former President said he was doing everything possible to cooperate in this effort and was pleased with the progress.

At present, 140 Cubans have signed the Charter of Cuban Unity. The signers are persons who were prominent in the economic and political life of Cuba, representatives of labor, professional people and students among the exiles as well as members of the Cuban brigade that invaded Cuba in April, 1961.

An executive committee of 47 members has been appointed. On Sunday it decided to postpone for 30 days the election of a central committee to give time to bring in Cubans of other tendencies, such as the raider groups.

A committee has been appointed to plan the collection of funds among Cubans and Americans in the United States to be used for military equipment. Another group is working on plans for action against the Castro regime.
