Hijacking Law
MEXICO CITY — Presi-

dent Gustavo Diaz Ordaz sent to the Senate Thursday a law asking for penalties of up to 20 years in prison for anyone causing deviation of an aircraft from its planned route through threats, violence or intimidation.

Mexico would be the first country with such a law. Four Mexican airliners have been hijacked and forced to fly to Cuba so far this year.
