EXILES REPORT Some Infiltrators Killed,

Some Captured

MIAMI (AP)-A Cuban exile group reported Thursday that some of its men had infiltrated eastern Cuba and fought with Fidel Castro forces.

The organization, Cuban Exile Representation — RECE — de-clined to give details "for security reasons." It said it confirmed the infiltration after "fragmentary reports" about it appeared in newspapers.

The Miami News said Monday that fragmentary reports indicated three men in the anti-Castro force were killed and some others captured in an armed encounter in Oriente Province.

RECE said in a statement: "This organization has been carrying on a plan of war activities against the Communist tyranny of Cuba consisting of coordination and liaison between interior forces which are fighting in Cuba and external forces, for the purposes of start-ing war."

The exile radio station WQBA said recently arrived refugees reported that 10 Cubans landed near Baracoa in eastern Cuba two weeks ago and encountered Castro forces. The refugees were quoted as saying there were casualties on both sides and that some of the infiltrators escaped.

The refugees were quoted as saying that among those killed in the encounter was Capt. Tico Herrera of the Cuban army.

Havana radio broadcasts monitored in Miami have not mentioned the encounter.
