Cuba Gets Last of 13 Invaders P DX 4/28/70 From News Dispatches

HAVANA, April 27—The Cuban Armed Forces Ministry announced today that the last members of a 13-man exile invasion force were captured over the weekend.

The announcement said two of the guerrillas were captured Sunday and two Friday. It added thet all of the invaders, weapons, including U.S.-made automatic rifles, were seized.

The small band of exiles landed in eastern Cuba on April 16 in an attempt to over-throw the Fidel Castro government.

Four of the invaders and five Cuban soldiers were killed in skirmishes in rough, unpopulated mountain country, according to Havana announcements.

The prisoners are expected to be tried before revolutionary tribunals.

In announcing the capture of the last remnants of the exile force, the Cuban armed forces statement warned: "Every mercenary who tries to invade our land will meet the same fate."

[In Miami, officals of Alpha 66, the exile organization that took credit for the invasion, said they had not received word of the defeat. "We will continue to increase our war effort," a spokesman for the anti-Castro organization said.]
