Cuba Seen Target in Arms Plot

NEW ORLEANS—Federal officials said nine persons arrested in Texas and Louisiana were allegedly conspiring to smuggle munitions for the overthrow of a foreign country, presumably Cuba.

As the arrests were being made Saturday night, a DC 4 aircraft was seized in Shreveport, La., containing 15,500 pounds of plastic explosives, 2,600 electrical blasting caps, 7,000 feet of prymacord and 25 electrical detonators.

Among those arrested were a prominent South Texas rancher banker and a former inspector with the U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service. The two were arrested at Eagle Pass, Texawhere they lived.
