Post 6-6-9 3 Cubans Indicted On Bomb Charges

NEWARK, N.J., June 5 (UPD)—Three members of the Cuban Nationalist Movement have been indicted by a Federal grand jury on charges of conspiring to bomb Cuban property in Canada.

property in Canada.

The indictment handed up Wednesday charged Guillermo Novo Sampol, 29, Felipe Martinez y Blanca, 25, and Hector Diaz Limontes, 35, with conspiring to damage or destory the Cuban consulate and the Cuban trade commission in Montreal and several Cuban steamships.

The conspiracy charges against the three members of the anti-Castro organization carry a maximum penalty of three years in prison and a \$5000 fine.
