

Anti-Castro Terrorist Ends First Year of Term

MIAMI (AP) — Dr. Or-

lando Bosch, the baby doctor who served a year in prison for his role in the Bay of Pigs invasion, was released today after a year of confinement. Bosch's release was the result of a court order that he be freed because of his activity as a physician. The court said that Bosch's efforts went forward to his release.

The 41-year-old Cuban was arrested here Oct. 11, 1961, for commanding a Communist freighter in the Bay of Pigs. He was serving the sentence in the Atlanta federal prison. Bosch is assigned to the Atlanta prison.

Bosch's replacement as head of the Revolutionary Recovery Government in Cuba is Manuel Mendive. Mendive was named last week. Bosch was in New York while working on a plan to get to President Nixon a petition with 113,000 signatures asking amnesty for Bosch.

PEALS FOR BOSCH Bosch and other Cuban convicts with him but free on bond are being pushed by attorney Melvin Greenblatt. The attorney said he will file to the U.S. Supreme Court a request to permit Bosch appeal bond, denied by the 5th Cir-

cuit Court in New Orleans.

A ruling on the conviction themselves is being expected. The appeals court is expected to rule among other things the illegal surreptitious evidence was admitted.

Bosch and one of his five sons were taken to Atlanta last month to visit the prison. Bosch's wife, MARIA BOSCH, who also was in prison, is still serving the sentence.

Dr. Bosch was in the hospital when he was cut from the prison. She asked, "At the time he was working in the prison January."

Bosch was sentenced for plotting to attack the United States and Cuba. He was sentenced to five years for conspiring to place explosives on ships of foreign registry, and three years for sending cables to the heads of government in Spain, Britain and Sweden threatening to attack them if those nations did not support the Cuban revolution. Bosch and other defendants were convicted of plotting to attack the United States.
