

Cuban Exile Is Held in Ship Bombing

MIAMI, Dec. 20 (AP)—FBI agents today arrested a Cuban identified with a militant anti-Castro group in connection with the bombing of a Spanish ship in Puerto Rico two months ago.

The FBI said the man, Jose Rodriguez, was arrested in Miami to the Miami Herald. Recovery Insurance Co. of Miami filed suit against the Cuban government in Miami.
