# Bomb-Toting Cuban Exile Arrested

TIPON, Ga., April 14 (UPI) — A Cuban exile was arrested today with two bombs hidden in his suitcase as he prepared to board a flight to Miami, apparently to join the Cuban revolution.

Authorities identified him as **Barcelo Baldo Garcia**, 34, of Havana, who was taken before U.S. Commissioner Eugene Schmitter in Valdosta and charged with violating the U.S. embargo against Cuba.

The United States Customs and Border Protection official, who also is a military aviator, said he believed Garcia had flown the plane.

The arrest was made as two suitcases were being loaded on the plane. One suitcase contained dynamite and small aerial bombs and the other propaganda written in Spanish.

Garcia speaks no English, authorities said, and he was assigned an interpreter for the hearing before the U.S. commissioner.
