

# Liberal Club Offices Damaged by a Bomb

NEW YORK, Aug. 19 (AP) — A bomb exploded today in the doorway of a West Side Manhattan building housing the offices of the Liberal Club, the Communist Daily World, the Communist newspaper.

The explosion wrecked the door, heavily damaged the entrance and scattered a large amount of debris on the sidewalk. Several people within 50 feet away escaped injury.

The explosion was almost simultaneous with a heavy bomb attack received by United Press International headquarters in New York City. Cuban agents are reported to have encouraged and furnished the bomb.

United Press International also received a telephone warning from a "Mr. Lozano", representing an alleged aid to Biafra group, that two bombs had been planted at the United Nations and one at the British Mission to protest lack of action on behalf of starving Biafrans.

Police said a search of both premises failed to locate any bombs.

The explosion at the West Side Liberal Club was the 20th since April 22 believed linked with anti-Castro Cuban groups. The first was at the Spanish national tourist office here and the last was Aug. 6
