Yesterday, April 17, 1963, was the second anniversary date of the unsuccessful "Bay of Pigs" invasion of Cuba. Today or tonight Jose Miro Cardona, head of the Cuban Revolutionary Council, is to make public a twenty three (23) page statement in which he will accuse the present United States Government Administration of not keeping their promises to the Cuban exiles.

A meeting of the Cuban Revolutionary Council will begin this afternoon and probably will last on into the night. Cardona is expected to resign from his post with the council. As a result of this meeting, it is expected that disturbances will take place in areas of heavy Cuban population, during the afternoon and darkness hours.

It is requested that Uniform cars patrolling in these areas particularly be on the lookout for these disturbances. At this point, this office has no information concerning any organized demonstrations.

Particular watch should be made on the Cuban Revolutionary Council headquarters, 17th Street and Biscayne Blvd., where these meetings are being held.
