Castro Foe Murdered

MIAMI—Juan Jose Peruyero, who
took part in the Bay of Pigs invasion
and later became a leader of Miami's
anti-Castro Cuban exiles, was assassinated as he left his home.

Police said Peruyero, in his mid-40s, was gunned down by two men who apparently had been waiting for him. No arrests were made, but police searched for two Latin men seen in the area by witnesses.

A friend, Raymond Molina, claimed the shooting was "another Castro execution." The Cuban Premier, he said, is "executing those opposed to communism and to his regime."
