

2 Bonds Revoked In Cuban Slaying

MIAMI, Nov. 22 (UPI)—The \$10,000 bonds of two men arrested in connection with the 1975 slaying of Cuban exile Luciano Nieves were ordered revoked today by County Judge Richard Fuller when the two failed to appear in his courtroom as ordered.

Enrique Velasco and Hector Carbonell had been ordered to appear after reports that the two men had been seen in Mexico.

Nieves, an associate of weekly newspaper publisher Rolando Masferrer, boss of Cuba's secret police under the regime of Dictator Fulgencio Batista, was gunned down last year in the parking lot at a hospital where he had gone to visit one of his children.
