[REDACTED], CIA, TELEPHONICALLY CONTACTED THE WRITER THIS  
DATE AT THREE FIFTY FIVE PM. HE ADVISED THAT THEY RECEIVED A CALL  
FROM ONE [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] STATED THAT HE WAS IN WEST GERMANY FROM NINETEEN  
FIFTY NINE TO NINETEEN SIXTY TWO AND HE RECALLED THAT HE  
RECEIVED INFORMATION FROM SOME LEFT WING ELEMENTS THAT PRESIDENT  
KENNEDY WOULD BE SHOT. [REDACTED] ADVISED CIA THAT HE WAS NOT A  
CRACKPOT AND THAT HE CANNOT REMEMBER SPECIFICALLY WHERE OR FROM  
WHOM HE RECEIVED THIS INFORMATION . HE STATED THAT HE WOULD  
ENDEAVOR TO RECALL THESE FACTS AND IF HE DID, HE WOULD PROMPTLY  
FURNISH THEM TO CIA.

For the information of the Bureau and Dallas there is enclosed for each one copy of a memorandum received 11/25/63, classified SECRET, from CIA, Miami.

Miami files indicate that SEGUNDO FRENTE DEL ESCAMBRAY is a revolutionary group led by ELOY GUTIERREZ MENOYO with headquarters in Miami. The name of one MANUEL RODRIGUEZ as of 7/30/63, appeared on a circular issued by SEGUNDO FRENTE DEL ESCAMBRAY as a member of its Key West, Fla., delegation. There is no identifying information and it should be noted that MANUEL RODRIGUEZ is a very common Spanish name.

It is noted that a copy has been furnished to Secret Service by CIA.

MEMORANDUM FOR: Federal Bureau of Investigation

SUBJECT : Reaction by Cuban Exile Community to President  
Kennedy's Death

1. This office in the aftermath of President Kennedy's death has initiated efforts to monitor the reactions of the local Cuban Exile Community, which have resulted in the following initial results:

2. It appears that the Miami Cuban Exile Community has begun accommodating itself to the realities of world politics and has initiated speculation on the future US policy re Cuba. Rumors are circulating among exile Cubans concerning the possible involvement of the Government of Cuba in President Kennedy's death. While the authors of these rumors have not been pinpointed, it is becoming evident that these rumors are directed primarily at provoking strong US action against Cuba. On the possibility that these rumors may have some shred of evidence to substantiate their objective, this office will continue to keep track of them and to conduct at least preliminary investigations of the more plausible ones to forward to your office.

3. In the above connection, one of our sources reported that he heard from one ~~Dora Causa~~ <sup>Flu.</sup> that Eloy Gutierrez Menoyo had stated on 21 November 1963 that "something very big would happen soon that would advance the Cuban cause." Dora Causa's sister is married to Rafael Dominguez Caballero who is a member of the ~~Segundo Frente del Escambray~~ of which Eloy Gutierrez Menoyo is the chief.

4. When taken out of context, the above remark becomes impossible to evaluate but it is typical of the rumors to which Cuban exiles tend at present to adhere to support whatever theory they may be expounding at the given moment.
