

## DR. PORTUONDO TO GIVE SPEECH

Cuban - American Rally  
for Nixon, Treen

The featured speaker at a Cuban-American rally for Richard Nixon and David Treen, scheduled for 8:30 p.m. Friday at the Jerusalem Temple, will be Dr. Emilio Nunez Portuondo of Miami, Fla.

A former president of the United Nations Security Council, Dr. Portuondo helped draft the Cuban Constitution in 1940 and represented his country as ambassador to five nations. He is the author of six books and the founder - director of "Latin American Events," published in Washington, D. C. His address here will be in Spanish and will be interpreted by Dr. Carlos Bringuier.

Treen, Republican candidate for Congress from the Second Congressional District and chairman of the Louisiana delegation to the National GOP Convention, also will address the rally. Other scheduled speakers are Robert Angers Jr., Nixon-Agnew presidential elector from the Third Congressional District, and Dr. Carlos de la Vega, New Orleans Chairman of Cuban-Americans for Nixon and Director of Latin American Relations at Ochsner Foundation Hospital.
