Persuant to our recent correspondent and your very helpful suggestions, I will be filing, tomorrow, a Petition and a Motion. I am sending two copies to the Department of Justice and will ask the clerk of the court what else is proper or required.I will, of course, also have copies to be filed with the case, Civil Action No. 718-70.

I regret the length because I know the Judge must have more then enough to read. However, I felt I should be specific and detailed so that I could inform him fully and to be fair to the Department of Justice, so they will know exactly what I allege and why.

Partly because of the length and partly because of the cost, I have not attached the letters quoted. Should this be desired, of course I will do that. Or, should the judge want any of them, to satisfy himself tust I have represented them fairly and not out of context.

Agein, I do thank you for your kindness. I hope my lack of knowledges of such matters has not led me into any serious deviation from custom.
