1. In order to fully resolve any information he claims to have in the King case, the Atlanta Office has been instructed to reinterview for full details and pin him down. Any pertinent information of substance will be fully run out. Results of interview and any additional inquiries will be furnished the Civil Rights Division.

2. Attached for approval is a letter to of ''Ebony' magazine advising him that results of any interview will be forwarded to the Civil Rights Division of the United States Department of Justice.
