CONCERNING MILLION DOLLAR BOUNTY AND HIS STATEMENT OF BOUNTY TO BE PAID BY "KK OF THE SOUTH" AND THE SOUTHERN BUSINESSMEN'S ASSOCIATION, CURTIS STATED THAT BY KK, HE DID NOT MEAN KU KLUX KLAN BUT EITHER "KENNEDY AND KING" OR "KILL KING" WAS HIS UNDERSTANDING OF THESE INITIALS WHEN HE HEARD THEM IN PRISON.
