In his book Post Mortem he analizes testimony of Dr Charles Carrico, published in the Commission's Hearings vol III, pp 361-2. In answering a question by Allen Dulles the doctor locates the President's wound of entry in the throat above the shirt collar. Both Representatives Hale Boggs and Gerald Ford were present during this interchange yet there is no mention of this cardinal fact in the Commission's Report.


