1st shot: ±Z-159/1: TH-EM, the Hard Evidence man, using a Carcano in T.S.B.D.'s window VI #1, fires first of two rounds; ±Z-155: bullet scars RAINIER'S PAVEMENT (a concrete particle wounds Jaquet's CHEEK) ricochets off south CURB into Commerce tunnel; to date it is unrecovered.

2nd shot: ±Z-158: Santapan, using another Carcano in D-T.B.'s window VI #1, fires first of two rounds; ±Z-160: bullet scars ELMER'S PAVEMENT, ricochets into RR yard, south of overpass; discovered by Lester 11 yrs later.

3rd shot: Z-187/8: Novel, standing near Sternman's on Grassy Knoll with umbrella, disguised Overland Fletcher Launcher at Ready, over his head (Santapan, 68°F) launches a poison-carrying, needle-nosed mini-rocket (dot): (see Utilita 5 of Z-202 for The Umbrella Man's position; also Pivonson 1 of Z-225) LaFayette enters President's THROAT above shirt-collar, below Adam's apple; impacted on the spine; it was removed by enlarging Fractology incision during pre autopsy examination

4th shot: ±Z-217/8: Santapan, firing second round; ±Z-220: bullet enters President's BACK and hits spine; removed at pre-autopsy examination; CE 899 was substituted for it and the FBI gave a receipt for the "missile" (AKA Will/80)

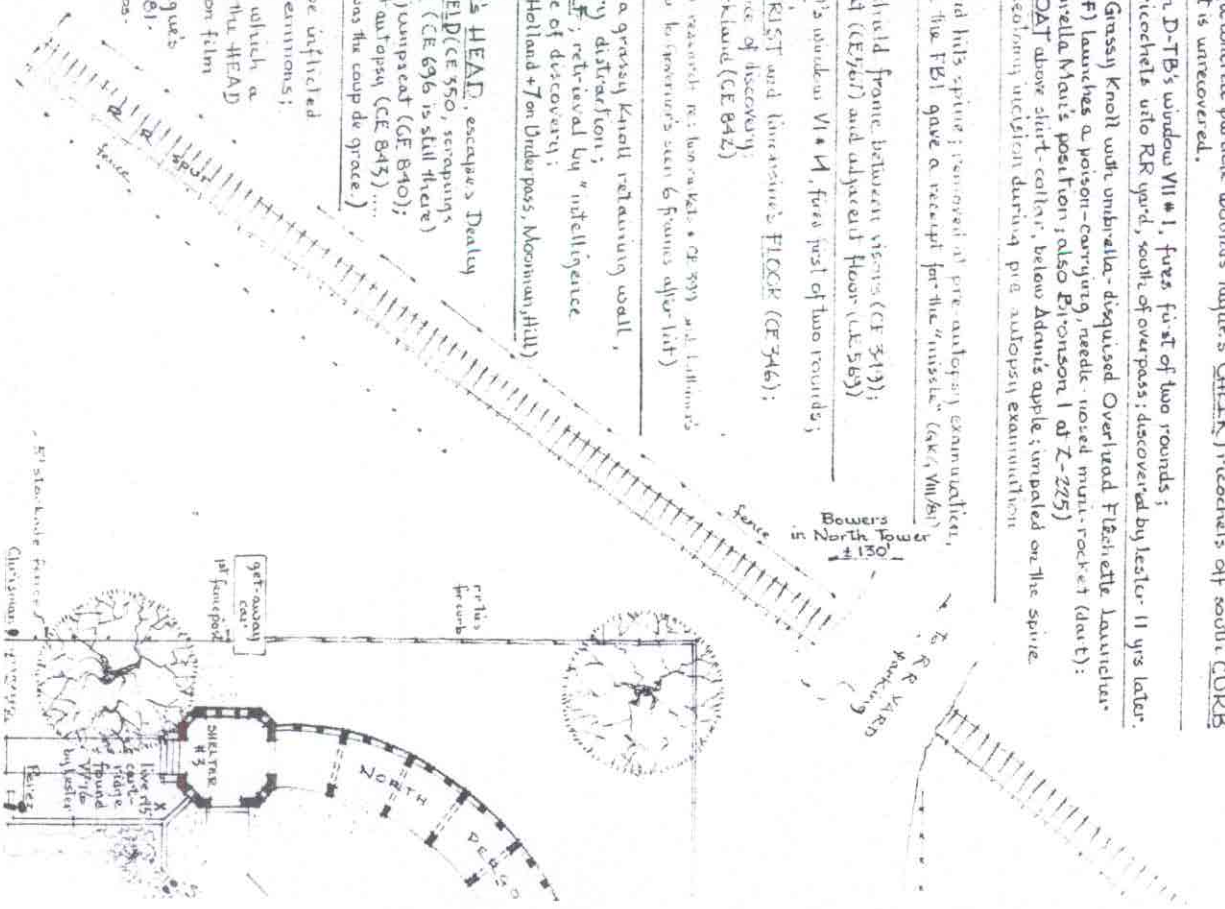
5th shot: ±Z-220: TH-EM fires second round; ±Z-221/2: bullet enters back in front window between views (CE 343); fragments recovered from front seat (CE 87) and adjacent floor (CE 589)

6th shot: Z-221/2: Seymour, using a Mauser in T.S.B.D.'s window VI #1, fires first of two rounds; ±Z-222: bullet scars WIFE, dentist's right; ±Z-223: fragments (Governor's CHEST, WRIST and literature's FLOCKER (CE 346); lance, nonrelating water abundance of discovery; particles from oral removed at Parkland (CE 842)

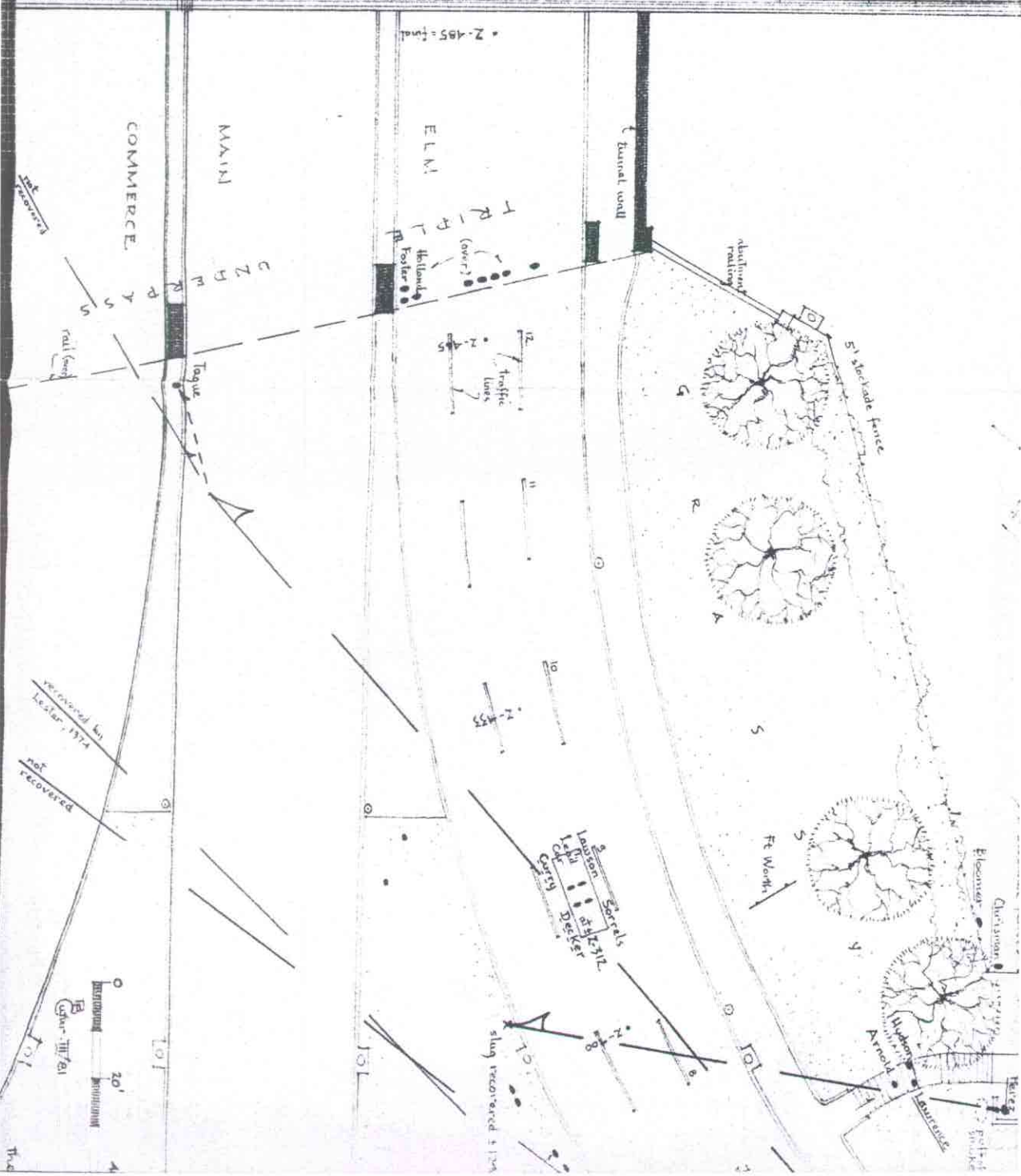
7th shot: ±Z-287: Parker, using a .44 pistol behind a grassy knoll retaining wall, fires a red-harrowing, diversionary distraction; bullet scars infield grass TURF; retrieved by "intelligence agent"; ±1240, unswayed avoidance of discovery; puff of smoke lingers a while (Holland + Ton Underpass, Moonman, Hill)

8th shot: Z-311: Seymour, fires second round; Z-312/3: bullet traverses top of President's HEAD, escapes Dealey Plaza; fragments scar WINDSHIELD (CE 550, remains CE 841) enter Governor's THIGH (CE 696 is still there) and were recovered from under jumpseat (CE 840); fragments also removed from head of autopsy (CE 843).... (7 seconds after LaFayette's poisoning, the Head Shot was the coup de grace.)

notes: wound of entry on the THROAT can only be identified ± Z-188 from a position luncheonette of Sternman's; there is no position in Dealey Plaza from which a bullet could inflict a wound of entry on the HEAD after Z-312/3 and produce the reaction seen on film this framing superimposes down #10 - R.E. Sprague's crossfire 70 and Cross fire 80 on GK 5, WEI, also issue of this framing, W-1-81 and TP's position JBC in TUM Fy 2B; camera angles that are indicated unique with staves for TH-EM and Z-mike on WZ....

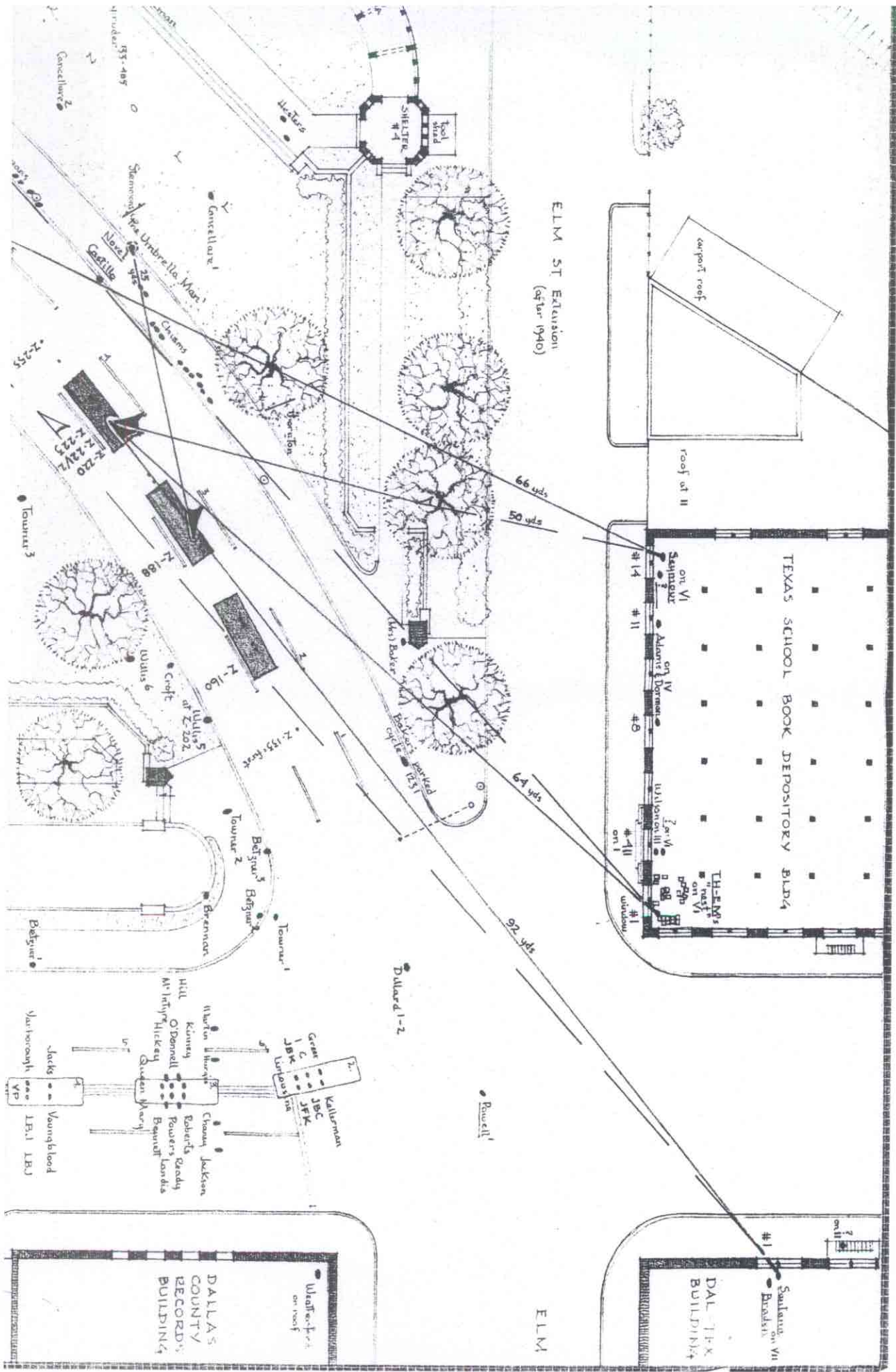
